Past examples include site maintenance at Ruapekapeka Pa, weeding at Ocean Beach, planting at Paradise Shores and fencing at the Whangarei Kiwi Sanctuary, where volunteers were lucky enough to meet a kiwi that needed a transmitter change.

There is an educational component each month which may include a talk from a knowledgeable ranger, meet a kiwi or learn about an historic site.
