Volunteer remotely. Bay of Islands Animal Rescue is looking for committed people who can offer short term care to needy pets in their own homes.

Would you like a pet but are not in a position to give long term commitment?

Do you have a spare room you could offer a needy cat or time to devote to cheering up an unhappy dog?

If you can't have a pet of your own or aren't able to foster would you like to help by fund raising or sponsoring a dog?

What you will be doing:
