- Contributing proactively as a member of the team, working to make things better

For clinical operations roles where you are required to drive, you will be required to meet Hato Hone St John medical standards

### COVID-19 Vaccinations

Booster vaccinations are required within a 6-month period of receiving your second vaccination. This means you will need to be fully vaccinated, including having or intending to receive your Booster prior to your commencement date. Proof of your COVID-19 vaccination will be requested as part of the recruitment process. This applies to all roles in St John.
